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I. **PROJECT**

1. Project objectives

The project's main objective was to disseminate good practices related to the mobility of students, and academic and administrative staff members, and to develop theses and assumptions to be followed to support international student mobility between universities.

Cooperation of the universities within the project aimed at widening and developing the knowledge, skills, and competencies of project participants, especially in the field of:

- increasing professional competencies,
- increasing their self-esteem and self-confidence,
- improving foreign language proficiency,
- developing key social competencies due to the cooperation in an international environment,
- increasing attractiveness in the workplace and labour market,
- improving teaching skills (teachers),
- enriching materials and educational aids.

Cooperation within the project is also aimed at:

- developing and realisation of the international strategy of participating universities,
- increasing of education level and quality,
- comparing and improving educational curricula, and in the case of Partner Universities,
- adjusting educational programmes to European standards Benchmarking,
- working on common educational programmes for master's students,
- preparing of programmes for double diplomas with Partner Universities,
- developing and exchange of cooperation proposals in the field of research activities that can result in international scientific projects and joint scientific publications.

Exchange of experience and good practices contributed to developing and disseminating ideas about studying abroad, indicating sources of funding for international academic exchange, representing good practices developed in the Universities.

Problems related to social, legal, and environmental barriers and ways of their solution have also been discussed.

Cooperation between the Universities definitely contributed to the increase of their prestige in regional and local educational markets.

2. Participating universities

a. Poland

Wyższa Szkoła Ekologii i Zarządzania w Warszawie (University of Ecology and Management in Warsaw)



University of Ecology and Management in Warsaw (UEM) is one of the best private technical – artistic universities in Poland. UEM, established upon the decision of the Ministry of National Education on 18 July 1995 and registered under number 62, more than 28 years conducts education in full-time and part-time bachelor's and master's studies.

Education at the University is conducted within two Faculties: the Faculty of Architecture and the Faculty of Engineering and Management, in which it is possible to study 11 fields of studies.

The mission of the University of Ecology and Management in Warsaw is high-quality, modern and flexible education of studies:

- ready to meet the developmental needs of information society and the knowledge-based
- enriching with their professionalism and intellectual mobility human capital of Masovia, Poland, and the EU,
- creating new economic, social, and cultural values in the spirit of the idea of sustainable development, according to expectations of the current and future labour market.

University authorities pay attention to the high level of education by hiring more than 300 specialists from different fields. Lecturers of UEM are not only scientific workers of other universities in Warsaw but also practitioners possessing business experience. Due to the combination of knowledge of lecturers and representatives of Faculty Councils of Employers, with whom programmes of studies are being discussed (according to European standards), studies in UEM are interdisciplinary, combine theory with practices, due to which are conducted with the application of design approach, teach students independence and ability to take responsible decisions.

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b. Armenia

(National University of Architecture and Construction of Armenia)

The National University of Architecture and Construction of Armenia (NUACA) is a higher school of Architecture and Construction that was founded in Yerevan in 1921. It is a technical school that has been in operation for nearly 100 years. The university consists of five faculties: Architecture, Design, Construction, Urban Economy and Ecology, and Management and Technology. Moreover, NUACA is the only university in Armenia preparing architects and construction engineers.

The internationalisation strategy of NUACA testifies its strong commitment to the promotion of sustainable development of international relations for educational, scientific, and technical cooperation. The strategy also includes actions to develop cooperation with architectural and construction-oriented universities abroad, intending to organise joint conferences, student project weeks, contests, and the promotion of academic mobility of teaching staff and students.

NUACA has participated in 17 TEMPUS, Erasmus Mundus, and currently Erasmus+ projects. Three Erasmus+ KA2 projects are ongoing: HERITAG, InnoCENS, and Iacobus+. As well as two KA1 projects with Universidade de Lisboa and the University of Alcala are currently active. NUACA has accomplished some EU-funded mobility projects: the Erasmus Mundus Infinity project and Erasmus+ KA1 with the Polytechnic University of Milan.

Besides, NUACA is actively implementing student exchange projects in the framework of Cooperation Agreements signed with European partner Higher Educational Institutions from Poland, Spain, Udine, etc.

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c. Azerbaijan

Azərbaycan Texnologiya Universiteti (Azerbaijan Technological University)



Azerbaijan Technological University was founded on the initiative of national leader Heydar Aliyev in 1970 in Ganja. The university provides education on one campus consisting of 6 educational and 1 administrative buildings. Besides, for the incoming students, there is a dormitory that can host international students in the city. The university offers 24 bachelor's, 23 master's, and 11 doctoral degree programmes and serves 3500 students with a teaching and research staff of 550.

UTECA's main educational fields are IT and Computer Science, Electronics and Telecommunication Engineering, Mechanical Engineering, Material Science and Engineering, Chemical Engineering, Textile Engineering, Food Sciences and Technology, Tourism Technologies, Machine-Building, Business Administration, Industrial Management, Public Administration, Management and Training-Education Technologies of Human Resources.

The University aims to provide physically and mentally strong progressive candidates who will stimulate the development of technologies in all strategic spheres of Azerbaijan. After the independence, the importance of the University to the country further increased. So, establishing several production enterprises in different areas of industry, as well as reconstruction of mining industries and rapid development of information communication technologies and such kind of directions make it necessary to bring new modern technical equipment to the country for the development of the non-oil sector.

Besides, Azerbaijan Technological University works on transforming education into a Technopark type higher education institution. In 2013 Azerbaijan Technological University changed its working approach by starting of Customer Orientation Programme, which shifts education quality and makes education in accordance with the requirements of customers. This situation makes ATU more attractive and each year number of students increases rapidly.

Internationalization is one of the major elements for the future development of Azerbaijan Technological University, UTECA participates in mobility programmes of Erasmus+ and cooperates with various universities in different countries. UTECA has enough experience and staff capacity to participate in international projects and deliver its values to the global markets.



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d. Brasil

 Universidade Federal Fluminense (Fluminense Federal University)



Founded in 1960, the Universidade Federal Fluminense (UFF) is a public institution, part of the Brazilian federal higher education system. Its headquarters are located in the city of Niterói and its campuses can be found in various parts of the state of Rio de Janeiro, as a result of a strong decentralization policy. There is also an out-of-state campus in Oriximiná, in the middle of the Amazon rainforest.

The Universidade Federal Fluminense is the largest federal university in Brazil with respect to number of students enrolled, and has nationally and internationally been ranked among the best Brazilian universities.

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
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g. Kosovo





The University of Applied Sciences in Ferizaj (UASF) was established by the Ministry of Education, Science, and Technology (MEST) on July 6, 2015, and was ratified by the Parliament of the Republic of Kosovo on July 16, 2015. The tradition of academic and scientific work in Ferizaj dates back to 1976 when the Assembly of Kosovo established the Centre for Higher Education. The Centre had a Machinery and Wood Industry Section, as well as a Workers' Section.

In the 1988 academic year, the Centre for Higher Education was abolished and the Technical High School was established, with the Machinery and Wood Industry Section, while the Workers' Section was completely abolished.

In the academic year 2002/03, new curricula were approved according to the Bologna system for basic studies (Bachelor), for the Department of Machinery with the profile: Artificial Materials Processing Technique and the Department of Wood Industry with the profile: Wood Processing.

With the decision of the Steering Council of the University of Prishtina, on 05.09.2005, Technical High School is transformed into the Faculty of Applied Technical Sciences (FATS), with the same Departments and profiles, while later at the Faculty of Applied Sciences (FAS), by enabling the Faculty to develop programmes beyond technical ones.

UASF organizes teaching in five faculties (basic studies and masters):

- Faculty of Architecture, Design, and Wood Technology:
 - Interior Architecture and Furniture Design;
 - Design and Construction of Wood products;
 - Green Architecture and Interior Design (Master).

These programmes offer studies in interior architecture, interior design, and the construction of wooden products.

- Faculty of Tourism and Environment:
 - Tourism and Hospitality Management;
 - Tourism and Innovation (Master).

This programme offers students the highest international standards in education, in the field of management in tourism and hospitality.



Faculty of Industrial Engineering and Informatics:

• Industrial Engineering with Informatics;

Applied Informatics (Bachelor);

• Engineering and Informatics (Master).

This programme offers studies that promote the strengthening of relations with industry and enables

students in the fields of engineering, especially in the field of Industrial Engineering with Informatics.

Faculty of Management:

• Industrial Management.

Industrial Management offers students the construction of new competencies by combining scientific and technological knowledge of management in industry, knowledge of communication, and creative

work.

Faculty of Applied Arts:

• Graphic Design and Multimedia.

The Graphic Design and Multimedia Programme was designed based on the labour market's demands and the Industrial Board's requirements, which operates within the University. Based on these requirements the programme will qualify professional staff with skills in graphic design services, who can use modern technology.

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h. Ukraine

Сумський державний університет (Sumy State University)



Sumy State University (SumDU) is a comprehensive higher education institution located in the city of Sumy, North-Eastern part of Ukraine. University follows the ideology of research, educational, and socially oriented institution where large-scale international cooperation and the focus on innovative technologies, in particular ICT, are prioritized. Educational and research activity of SumDU is comprehensive and embraces a wide scope of areas from engineering and ICT to natural sciences, medicine, and humanities.

The University currently serves about 12,000 students who are pursuing bachelor's, master's, and Ph.D. degrees in 57 majors and 25 fields of knowledge. Currently, more than 1300 foreign students at SumDU represent 46 countries worldwide. More than 20 study programmes are entirely taught in English. SumDU is highly ranked at the national level, enters the TOP-group (3%) of leading universities of the world, and is classified as a university with high research intensity according to the QS World University Rankings and is included in THE World University Rankings by Times Higher Education.

SumDU is a signatory of Magna Charta Universitatum and a reliable member of the most authoritative international organizations - the International Association of Universities and European University Association.

The partnership network of SumDU includes about 300 universities from 58 countries of the world. SumDU is a permanent partner of EU grant programs: Erasmus+, Horizon 2020, Horizon Europe. Moreover, the UN, NATO, DAAD, American and British Council programs are covered as well. Annually, about 400 grants are realized. For the last 5 years, the amount of grant research work has increased in 20 times.

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Національний авіаційний університет (National Aviation University)



National Aviation University is one of the most powerful aviation-related higher educational facilities in the world, with about 25,000 students enrolled, including nearly 1,500 foreigners from 55 countries. Rector of National Aviation University is a Doctor of Technical Sciences, professor Maksym Lutskyi.

The origin of the University dates back to aviation courses organized by Kyiv Polytechnic Institute in the late XIX century, while the independent history began in 1933 by the Resolution of the Council of People's Commissars of the USSR. According to it Kyiv Aviation Institute was founded at the aviation department of Kyiv Polytechnic Institute. Later its name was being changed many times: Kyiv Institute of Civil Aviation (1947), Kyiv Institute of Civil Aviation (1965), Kyiv International University of Civil Aviation (1994), National Aviation University (2000).

For 85 years of its history more than 200,000 highly skilled professionals has been trained in this higher aviation educational institution. Among them there are well-known scientists, heads of aviation companies, enterprises, organizations and institutions that provide aircraft flights, their maintenance and repair, transportation of passengers and cargo.

The university launched powerful scientific schools in the fields of management, mechanics, electronics, electrical engineering, materials science and computer technology. Their founders were Professor T. Bashta, academicians O. Kuhtenko and G. Pukhov, corresponding members O. Pen'kov, B. Malynowsky, Professors A. Grokhol'skiy, L. Il'nytsky and others.

Due to the national and international recognition of the significant contribution to the development of national higher education and science, and by the Decree of the President of Ukraine, Leonid Kuchma granted national status to the University in September 2000.

The main competitive advantage of the University both in the Ukrainian and global educational markets is its aviation component. The University trains future pilots, unmanned aerial vehicle operators, groundhandlers for aviation equipment and aircraft engines, air traffic controllers and engineers, on-board equipment and avionics specialists, radio electronics experts, designers of modern airports, airfields, aviation and logistics experts, cybersecurity and systems diagnostics specialists,



environmentalists, economists, lawyers, psychologists, physicians, and other specialists. Thanks to

NAU's international collaboration with world's leading universities, our students are able to participate

in internships and get dual diplomas.

Today the university includes five institutes, ten faculties, Department of Military Training, six colleges,

two lyceums, and Flight Academy in Kropyvnytskyi. The Pearl of the University is one of the largest

aviation training hangars in Europe. Also, at NAU there is a training airfield and a field for aviation

ground engineering, training complexes, educational and scientific aerodynamic complex based on a

subsonic wind tunnel TAD-2. The campus consists of 11 dormitories, a canteen able to host up to 1,000

people, an Internet cafe, a student's Bistro, a health center, equipped with modern diagnostic and

medical equipment, a disease prevention department, a culture and arts center with 1,500 seats, and

a sports center. The book stock of NAU Scientific and Technical Library consist of more than 2.6 million

books.

Among partners are Ukraine's leading aviation enterprises: State Aviation Service, State Space Agency,

Antonov State Enterprise, Ukroboronprom, the Boryspil International Airport, the Kyiv International

Airport, the Odesa International Airport), UIA, and SE Plant 410 of Civil Aviation.

The NAU Diploma has been and remains the hallmark of quality and professional excellence and is

recognized as competitive in many countries. The motto of the National Aviation University, which

- 8 administrative staff members 1 from the National Technical University of Ukraine "Igor Sikorsky Kyiv Polytechnic Institute", 3 from the University of Applied Sciences in Ferizaj, 1 from the Sumy State University, 2 from the Santo Domingo Institute of Technology, and 1 from the National University of Life and Environmental Sciences of Ukraine.

Three academic staff members of UEM conducted lectures for students of Partner Universities - 1 the National University of Architecture and Construction of Armenia, 1 in the Santo Domingo Institute of Technology, and 1 in the University of Applied Sciences in Ferizaj.

Four administrative staff members of UEM took part in training or job shadowing organised by Partner Universities – 1 in the Azerbaijan Technological University, 1 in the Santo Domingo Institute of Technology, 1 in the University of Applied Sciences in Ferizaj, and 1 in the Caucasus University.

It is also worth to mention that on 29 May - 02 June 2023 the University of Ecology and Management in Warsaw organised Staff Week for representatives from Partner Universities, which was devoted to the issues concerning forms of cooperation with the socio-economic environment, international marketing and cooperation, education systems in Poland and Partner Countries, education quality assurance systems and tools, international exchange and information on Erasmus+ Programme, possibilities of educational and research cooperation between Partner Universities, plans concerning further cooperation within Erasmus+ Programme, Polish history and culture, and learning basics of Polish language. During Staff Week representatives of Partner Universities shared good practices and discussed main problems during realisation of projects.

This event has strongly contributed to:

- development and realisation of the internationalisation strategy of Partner Universities;
- learning the structure, organisational culture, and way of operating of the Partner Universities;
- exchange of experiences related to structures, mechanisms, and improving the quality of education and quality assurance tools;
- improving the quality of education and services provided for students;



My trip to Armenia (carried out within the framework of the Erasmus + mobility programme) took place under special circumstances, the uniqueness of which, with each passing year, acquires in my memory brighter shades of colour, in a word polarizing. The mobility took place in a year that was troublesome for all of us, punctuated by incoming waves of increasing Covid-19 cases, and the

following intervals of time coinciding with the decreasing balance of human misery, created only windows when it was possible to exchange knowledge between universities at the international level - assuming the physical presence of the lecturer abroad. This was the case for me, the trip took place from 07.06-12.06 of 2021.

Immediately after landing in Yerevan (Yerevan), I went to the National University of Architecture and Construction of Armenia. The University, as well as the entire city, made a very positive impression on me. The city captivated me with its magnificent monuments, especially the unusual architecture interspersed with ornate ornaments. And the University with its high level, professional staff, with great academic achievements in the field of interior design and design. were discussed: the rendering of the mood of the created interior with the help of skilful handling of light, working with a virtual camera and the conscious extraction of depth of field to emphasize the plasticity of the scene.

The second part of the training presented the video-mapping technique, i.e. a technology that allows the precise display of multimedia projections on elements of scenery or any spatial objects. As a result of such action, it becomes possible to develop a spatial illusion, giving a different context to static elements of scenery, or entire facades of architectural buildings. During the workshop we used software (SketchUp+V-Ray, and Resolume Arena).

After the end of the class, I provided their participants with training courses specially prepared for the occasion.

I evaluate the course of my mobility in Armenia very positively, the trip allowed me to gain valuable professional experience in working in an intercultural environment, contributed to the expansion of my professional circle of contacts, and significantly contributed to increased job satisfaction.
